

EARLAM'S CORONAVIRUS POLICY

At Earlams we consider personal and food hygiene to be of paramount importance. All our volunteers have undergone specific training in these matters and instructions are available to us all. At this time we are re-emphasising those instructions to all our volunteers.

It is our intention to strictly follow any Government guidance which may be forthcoming in the coming days and weeks and we realise that this may well impact upon the services we are able to offer to the local community.

We intend, for the moment, to continue to offer our normal facilities but must ask all customers to recognise that we are staffed exclusively by volunteers. We anticipate that some may in the coming weeks have commitments, for a variety of personal reasons, which take priority over their wish to contribute to Earlams and it may well leave us unable to offer the full service which customers enjoy. We may have to restrict our opening hours or, on occasions, close the shop, café or gallery at very short notice.

Earlams is a community facility staffed by a relatively small number of local residents (with some from further afield) for the benefit of both the local and wider community. If for any reason our service is reduced in the next couple of months we know you will understand the reasons. With your help and support Earlams will continue to be at the heart and soul of Styal but please be patient with us at this difficult time
